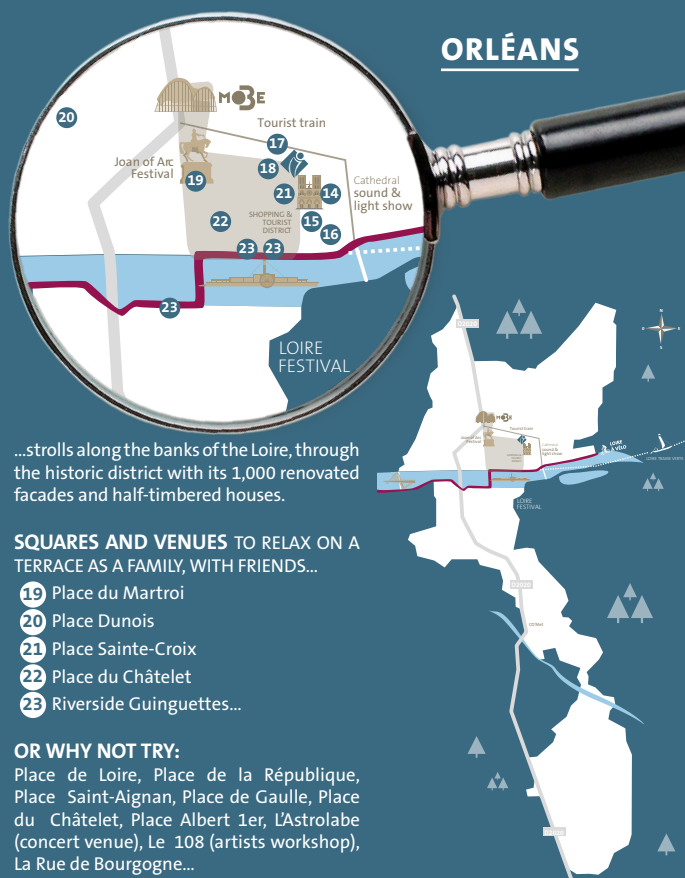

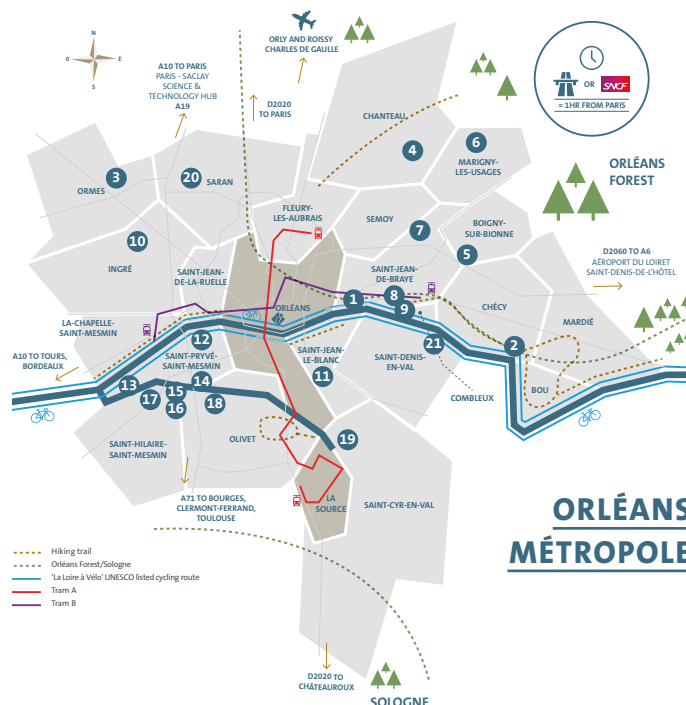

This typical Neo-Renaissance mansion opens the doors of its Salon d'Honneur and Wedding Room. Immerse yourself in a sumptuous setting which once hosted royal guests such as Charles IX and Henri IV!

SAINTE-CROIX CATHEDRAL

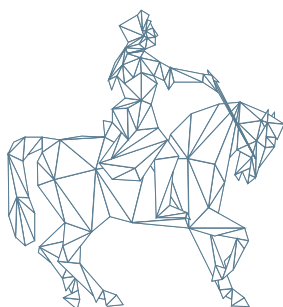
Standing 114m tall, this cathedral offers a unique charm and 10 stained glass windows retracing the life of Joan of Arc. From its Romanesque origins to its final Gothic airs, it was built over a period of more than 600 years.

HISTORIC CITY CENTRE

The historic centre of Orléans offers an exceptional architectural heritage, lined with half-timbered houses and Renaissance facades. Accept an invitation to wander, to lose yourself in the byways of this historic market district which has recently undergone extensive rehabilitation.

JOAN OF ARC

The girl who saved Orléans in May 1429, who is celebrated every May during her very own festival... Joan of Arc, the Maid of Orléans was beatified in May 1920.

Our heroine is depicted in myriad places around the city, so keep your eyes peeled for stained glass windows, statues, paintings, street and place names, and her 'house' on the Place du Général de Gaulle.
