

/ THE METROPOLIS ON THE ROYAL RIVER

The Loire, the largest river in France, crosses Orléans from east to west and offers a permanent spectacle. Listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2000, the 280 km of the Loire Valley is an exceptional site for its biological diversity as well as its historical and cultural wealth.

ORLÉANS, A GREEN METROPOLIS


Built on rich soil, Orléans Métropole has a remarkable tree-growing heritage, as well as a horticultural tradition crowned by the presence of rose, peony and clematis. These riches, scattered throughout the heart of many parks and gardens, are an invitation to stroll and delight the senses.

/ THE CITY OF JOAN OF ARC

Joan of Arc and the French troops would drive the English out from the siege of Orléans on 8 May 1429. The city has always kept the memory of her arrival alive through the medallions that line the streets, on the stained glass windows of the cathedral, in painting, in sculpture... Don't miss the Joan of Arc Festival, a unique event in France, and classified since 2018 as Intangible Cultural Heritage.

A METROPOLIS THAT REACHES OUT

1 hour from Paris, Orléans Métropole is an ideal starting point to visit the famous châteaux of the Loire Valley and the Loiret. Some are less than 1 hour's drive away, such as Châteaux de Sully-sur-Loire, Meung-sur-Loire, La Ferté-Saint-Aubin, Chamerolles, Chambord or Blois.

You can also appreciate its natural heritage classified as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in the Loire Valley section. You can learn about the importance of this wild river during a traditional flat-bottom boat ride.

IN THE FOOTSTEPS OF JOAN OF ARC

Joan of Arc and French troops entered the city on 29 April 1429 and drove the English out from the siege of Orléans on 8 May 1429. The history of the city is inseparable from that which marked a turning point in the Hundred Years War. Orléans has always kept the memory of her time there... For a day, go back in time and follow in the footsteps of Joan of Arc...



MEDIEVAL TREASURES: from the cathedral to the crypts:

Head down into the city basements! Discover the Saint-Aignan and Saint-Avit crypts, true underground vaults serving as sepulchres and remains in Romanesque style erected in the 11th century. Then explore the Bannier's Door, bearing witness to the second medieval wall around Orléans which protected the city in the 15th century.

ORLÉANS AND ITS MUSEUMS

The FRAC Centre-Val de Loire: a place of discovery, the contemporary art collection offers visitors a programme of exhibitions and a cultural schedule based around the relationships between art, architecture and design.

The Museum of Fine Arts: it has one of the most largest collections of European paintings in France as well as an exceptional display of pastels.

Hôtel Cabu - Museum of History and Archaeology: the museum houses the treasure of Neuvy-en-Sullias, as well as objects and works evoking the history of Joan of Arc and Orléans.

Orléans Museum for Biodiversity and the Environment (MOBE): Its facade, colonised by plants, is an integral part of the living collection. An urban greenhouse highlights the biodiversity of the Loire basin. On the top floor, a forum allows visitors to discuss themes related to the environment.



SECRETS OF BARREL-MAKING

A town in the Loire region, until the eve of the First World War, Chécy's activity was strongly focused on farming and the wine trade, as well as barrel-making. With nearly 3000 items, the Cooperage Museum retraces the making of barrels, the making and storage of wine, as well as the daily life of the peasant-winegrowers of the past through the winegrower's house and its agricultural outbuildings.

RIGHT BANK, LEFT BANK

Discover the gateway to the UNESCO-listed Loire Valley and step back in time on the north bank of the river. The Château de Sullysur-Loire, made up of 14 rooms, traces the history of the Duke of Sully through a rich collection of paintings, tapestries, statues and painted decorations. The basilica of Saint-Benoit-sur-Loire houses the relics of St Benoit, patron saint of Europe. Then there's the Carolingian oratory of Germigny-des-Prés, which is one of the oldest Christian sanctuaries in France today.







CHÂTEAU DE MEUNG-SUR-LOIRE

It's one of the largest and oldest châteaux in the Loiret which, until the French Revolution, was the property of the bishops of Orléans. Many kings stopped there such as Louis XI and François I. Discover 20 furnished rooms, from the kitchen to the baths, and more than 2000 objects placed in situ. This building is nicknamed "the château with two faces" because of its medieval and classical facades.



CHÂTEAU DE CHAMEROLLES

The medieval château was transformed by Lancelot du Lac, chamberlain to King Louis XII, into a Renaissance residence. The setting reveals the history of perfume invented during the Renaissance. Flasks, perfume organ and other objects highlight this luxury product that we cannot do without today. Its French-style gardens, where flowers and vegetable plants blend harmoniously, as well as its pond.

CHÂTEAU DE LA FERTÉ-SAINT-AUBIN

Located in the heart of Sologne, discover its 15 furnished rooms over three floors. From the château, which can be visited from the cellar to the attic, via the staff rooms, billiard room or dining room, to the stables, come and discover a different type of Loire château. 

The general conditions of sale comply with the provisions of article R.211-12 of the Tourism Code. To comply with the legal provisions, the following articles of the said Code are reproduced:

Any offer and any sale of the services mentioned in Article L.211-1 give rise to the delivery of appropriate documents that meet the rules defined by this section.

* Article R211-3-1 Amended by Decree no.2017-1871 of 29 December 2017 - art. 2

The exchange of pre-contractual information or provision of contractual conditions is carried out in writing. They can be done electronically. The name or company name and address of the organiser or retailer as well as the indication of their registration in the register provided for in article L.141-3 or, where applicable, the name, address and indication of the registration of the federation or union mentioned in the second paragraph of article R.211-2 are given

* Article R 211-4 Amended by Decree no.2017-1871 of 29 December 2017 - art. 2

Prior to the conclusion of the contract, the organiser or retailer must provide the traveller with the following information:

1 The main characteristics of the travel services:

a) The destination(s), itinerary and periods of stay, with the dates and, when accommodation is included, the number of nights included;

b) The means, characteristics and categories of transport, the places, dates and times of departure and return, the duration and place of stopovers and connections. When the exact time has not yet been set, the organiser or retailer will inform the traveller of the approximate time of departure and return;
c) The location, main characteristics and, if applicable, tourist category of accommodation under the rules of the country of destination;

d) Meals provided;

e) Tours, excursions or other services included in the total price agreed for the contract;

f) Where it's not apparent from the context, whether any travel services will be provided to the traveller as a member of a group and, in this case, if possible, the approximate size of the group g) When the benefit of other tourism services provided to the traveller relies on effective verbal communication, the language in which these services will be provided. h) Information on whether the trip or holiday stay is in any way general, adapted to people with reduced mobility and, at the request of the traveller, precise information on the suitability of the trip or holiday stay, to the needs of the traveller;

2 The corporate name and geographical address of the organiser and retailer, as well as their telephone and, if applicable, electronic contact details;

3 The total price including taxes and, if applicable, any fees, charges or other additional costs, or, when these cannot be reasonably calculated before conclusion of the contract, an indication of the type of additional costs the traveller may still have to bear;

5 The minimum number of people required for the trip or stay to go ahead and the deadline mentioned in II of article L.211-14 preceding the start of the trip or stay for possible termination of the contract should this number not be reached;

6 General information concerning the applicable passport or visa conditions, including the approximate duration for obtaining visas, as well as information on health formalities in the country of destination;

7 A statement indicating that the traveller can terminate the contract at any time before the start of the trip or stay, upon payment of appropriate termination fees or, where applicable, standard termination fees claimed by the organiser or retailer, in accordance with I of article L.211-14;

8 Information on compulsory or optional insurance covering the costs of terminating the contract by the traveller or on the cost of assistance, covering repatriation, in the event of accident, illness or death.

With regard to the packages defined in E of 2 of A of II of Article L. 211-2, the organiser or retailer and the professional to whom the data are transmitted ensure that each of them provides, before the traveller is bound by a contract, the information listed in this article insofar as it is relevant to the travel services they offer.

The form by which the information listed in this article is brought to the attention of the traveller is set by joint order of the minister responsible for tourism and the minister responsible for the economy and finance. This decree specifies the minimum information to be brought to the attention of the traveller when the contract is concluded by telephone.

The information mentioned in 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 and 7 of article R.211-4 communicated to the traveller is part of the contract and can only be modified under the conditions defined in article L.211-9.

* Article R211-6 Amended by Decree no.2017-1871 of 29 December 2017 - art. 2

The contract must include, in addition to the information defined in article R.211-4, the following information:

1 The particular requirements of the traveller that the organiser or retailer has accepted;

2 A statement indicating that the organiser as well as the retailer are responsible for the proper performance of all travel services included in the contract in accordance with article L.211-16 and that they are required to provide assistance to the traveller if they are in difficulty in accordance with article L.211-17-1; 3 The name of the entity responsible for insolvency protection and its contact details, including its geographical address;

4 The name, address, telephone number, e-mail address and, where applicable, fax number of the organiser's local representative or of the retailer, a point of contact or other service through which the traveller can quickly contact the organiser or retailer and communicate with them effectively,

request assistance if the traveller is in difficulty or complain about any non-compliance noted during the execution of the trip or stay;

5 A statement indicating that the traveller is required to communicate any non-compliance they find during the execution of the trip or stay in accordance with II of Article L.211-16;

6 When minors, unaccompanied by a parent or other authorised person, are travelling on the basis of a contract including accommodation, information enabling direct contact to be established with the minor or person responsible for the minor at the place of stay; 7 Information on the internal complaints procedures available and on the

out-of-court dispute resolution mechanisms and, where applicable, on the trader's legal entity and the online dispute resolution platform provided for in Regulation (EU) No. 524/2013 of the European Parliament and Council;

8 Information on the right of the traveller to assign the contract to another traveller in accordance with article L.211-11.

With regard to the packages defined in E of 2 of A of II of article L.211-2, the professional to whom the data is transmitted informs the organiser or retailer of the conclusion of the contract giving rise to the creation of a package. The professional provides them with the necessary information to be able to fulfil their obligations as an organiser. As soon as the organiser or retailer is informed of the creation of a package, they provide the traveller, on a durable medium, with the information mentioned in 1 to 8.

The traveller can assign their contract to a transferee who fulfils the same conditions as they do to complete the trip or stay, as long as this contract has no effect.

Unless stipulated more favourable to the transferor, the latter is required to inform the organiser or retailer of their decision by any means allowing them to obtain an acknowledgment of receipt at the latest seven days before the start of travel. This transfer is not subject, under any circumstances, to prior authorisation from the organiser or retailer.

When the contract includes an

express possibility of a price revision, within the limits

provided for in article L.211-12, it mentions the precise methods for calculating, both upward and downward, such price variations, in particular the amount of transport costs and related taxes, the currency(ies) that may have an impact on the price of the trip or stay, the part of the price to which the variation applies, as well as the rate of the currency(ies) used as a reference when establishing the price appearing in the contract. In the event of price reductions, the organiser or retailer has the right to deduct its actual administrative expenses from the reimbursement due to the traveller. At the request of the traveller, the organiser or retailer provides proof of these administrative expenses.

When, before the traveller's departure, the organiser or retailer is forced to make a modification to one of the essential elements of the contract, if it cannot meet the specific requirements mentioned in 1 of article R.211-6, or in the event of a price increase of more than 8%, it informs the traveller as soon as possible, in a clear, understandable and visible manner, on a durable medium, about:

1 The proposed changes and, if applicable, their repercussions on the price of the trip or stay;

2 The reasonable period of time within which the traveller must inform the organiser or retailer of their decision;

3 The consequences of the traveller's failure to respond within the time limit;

4 If applicable, the other service offered, as well as its price.

When contract amendments or the replacement service lead to a reduction in the quality of the trip or stay or its cost, the traveller is entitled to an adequate price reduction.

If the contract is cancelled and the traveller does not accept any other service, the organiser or retailer shall refund all payments made by or on behalf of the traveller as soon as possible and in any event no later than fourteen days after the contract is cancelled, without prejudice to compensation in accordance with Article L.211-17.

The organiser or retailer shall make the reimbursements required under II and III of article L.211-14 or, under I of article L.211-14, shall reimburse all payments made by or on behalf of the traveller less the appropriate cancellation costs. These reimbursements to the traveller are made as soon as possible and in any case within fourteen days at the latest after the contract has been terminated.

In the case provided for in III of article L.211-14, the additional compensation the traveller is likely to receive is at least equal to the penalty they would have incurred had they cancelled on that date.

Assistance due by the organiser or retailer in application of article L.211-17-1 consists in particular of:

1 Providing useful information on health services, local authorities and consular assistance;

2 Helping the traveller make long-distance communications and find other travel services.

The organiser or retailer is entitled to charge a reasonable price for such assistance if the difficulty is caused intentionally by the traveller or by their negligence. The invoiced price does not in any case exceed the actual costs borne by the organiser or retailer.

PARTICULARS OF SALE

Article 1 - The Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme tourist office ensures the reservation and sale of all types of services for trips and stays, in the general interest and in its area of operation. It facilitates reception and improves the conditions of tourist stays.

Article 2 - Responsibility: SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme is responsible under the terms of article L.211-16 of the Tourism Code which states:

"The professional who sells a tourist package mentioned in 1 of I of article L.211-1 is fully responsible for the performance of the services provided for in this contract, whether these services are performed by itself or by other providers of travel services, without prejudice to its right of recourse against them.

The professional who sells a travel service mentioned in 2 of I of article L.211-1 is fully responsible for the performance of the service provided by this contract, without prejudice to its right to recourse against the service provider.

However, the professional can be exempted from all or part of its responsibility by providing proof that the damage is attributable either to the traveller or to a third party outside the provision of the travel services included in the contract and is of an unforeseeable or inevitable nature, or in exceptional and unavoidable circumstances.

When an organiser or retailer pays damages and interest, grants a price reduction or fulfils other obligations that are incumbent upon it, it may seek compensation from any third party who contributed to the event giving rise to the compensation, price reduction or other obligations".

Articles 3 - Service duration: The client signing the contract concluded for a specific date may not, under any circumstances, claim any right to remain in the premises at the end of the service.

Article 4 – Reservation: The reservation of a service becomes firm when a deposit of 30% and a copy signed, read and approved by the customer have been returned to SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme before the deadline appearing on the booking contract. Any telephone or written option is retained by SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme only as an interest in one of its services. It cannot complete any reservation on its part without acceptance by the customer of the reservation contract.

Article 5 - Payment of the balance: The customer undertakes to pay SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme, on presentation of a pro forma invoice, the balance for the agreed service remaining due, and this one month before the start of the first service booked. A customer who has not paid the balance by the agreed date is considered to have cancelled their stay. Therefore, the service is again offered for sale and no refund will be made.

Article 6 - Invoicing: At the end of the services, SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme will draw up a customer invoice.

Article 7 - Late registrations: In the event of registration less than 30 days before the start of the service, full payment will be required upon booking.

Article 8 - Vouchers: Upon receipt of full payment for the services purchased, SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme will send the customer one or more vouchers to be handed over upon arrival to each service provider. Article 9 - Arrival: The customer must arrive on the days and at the times mentioned on each voucher. If this is not possible, the customer undertakes to notify SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme. In the event of late arrival or a last-minute problem, the customer must notify the service provider whose address and telephone number appear on the voucher.

Article 10 - Cancellation by the customer:

Any cancellation must be notified by registered letter to SPL Orléans Val de Loire

Tourisme. Should one or more participants not turn up at the customer's arrival time, no refund will be made, unless the service provider decides otherwise. Should there be a reduction in headcount before the balance is paid, a reassessment of the cost of the trip will be considered (in the event of a number of people less than the number indicated on the commercial offer and/or reservation contract).

Cancellation fees retained:

- between 30 and 21 days: 25% of the price per person

- between 20 and 8 days: 50% of the price person

- between 7 and 2 days: 75% of the price per person

- less than 2 days of departure or no-show of the group: 100% of the price per person.

Article 11 - Interruption of the service: In the event of interruption of the service by the customer, no reimbursement will be made unless the reason for the interruption is covered by the customer's cancellation insurance.

Article 12 - Capacity: The contract drawn up by SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme mentions a precise number of people. If the final number of

people exceeds the reception capacity provided by the proposed provider, the provider can refuse additional customers, terminate the reservation contract (in the latter case, the price of the service remains with SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme) or offer another service provider for additional people.

Article 13 - Hotels: the prices include rental of the room and breakfast or half-board or full board. Unless otherwise specified, they do not include drinks. When a guest occupies a single room intended to accommodate two people, they are charged a supplement called a "single or individual room supplement". On the day of departure, the room must be vacated by noon.

Tourist tax is mentioned for each reservation as a supplement.

Article 14 - Claims: Any claim

relating to a service must be sent, as soon as possible, by post to SPL Orléans Val de Loire Tourisme, the only body competent to make a decision.

Article 15 - Applicable law: The

special and general sales conditions are subject to French law. Any dispute relating to their interpretation and/or execution is the responsibility of the French courts, in this case the Court of Orléans.
